From medieval seeds planted long ago, exuberant traditions of Byzantine chanting in Asia Minor continued to flower during Ottoman rule. With the Asia Minor Disaster—an ethnic cleansing that included the 1922 burning of Smyrna (İzmir)—Greek-speaking refugees fled to Greece and elsewhere around the world. With them they brought their own traditions of Byzantine chanting. Catch a musical glimpse of a city and culture that exists today only in the memory of its diaspora, infused with irrepressible joy and transcendent beauty.

HOW SWEET THE SOUND

KINGDOM SOUND GOSPEL CHOIR + CAPPELLA ROMANA

African American composers, poets, and hymnographers join musicians from multiple traditions for events exploring the intersections between African American and Orthodox sacred music.

We will open the concert with *Bright Sadness*, Orthodox hymns based on African American spirituals by the nun Mother Katherine Weston. The second half features *Vespers: How Sweet the Sound* by jazz musician and composer Dr. Shawn Wallace. Drawing on both Black Gospel and Orthodox musical settings, *How Sweet the Sound* highlights the connections between these traditions in a setting of Orthodox Vespers.

The Tallis Scholars return to our series with a program spanning Lent and Easter, especially poignant this year as their tour takes place between the dates of Easter, March 31 on the Gregorian calendar and May 5 on the Julian. Two expansive settings of the Lamentations (White and Tallis) fill the first half with the second focusing on the events of the Passion and the Resurrection. They will sing the complete cycle of William Byrd's propers for Easter Day, in which the earthquake at Christ's crucifixion is depicted musically at "Terra tremuit."


