Experience ecstatic Byzantine chants for the saint adorning the rite of Hagia Sophia of Constantinople, sung by the women and men of Cappella.

Followed by a residency sponsored by UCLA with a concert and recording session for future release, with the chants sung in acoustic auralizations of medieval churches in Thessaloniki.

Requiem for the Forgotten by Frank La Rocca for choir, organ, and strings commemorates the displaced and the homeless, championing the inherent dignity of every person.

The program opens with the a cappella *Mass for Double Choir* by Josef Rheinberger (1839–1901), who dedicated it to Leo XIII, a pope known for his advocacy for social justice.

Requiem for the Forgotten appears on the Cappella Records recording by Benedict XVI Ensemble, led by the esteemed Richard Sparks, who will also direct Cappella Romana in these concerts, with 45th Parallel Universe.

English cantillation of Holy Week's drama mixes with soul-stirring Orthodox hymns sung in Slavonic, Greek, and English, accompanied by string quartet and bells played by our friends in 45th Parallel Universe.

These concerts are given in memory of Fr. Ivan, our beloved and much-missed friend who wrote his longest choral work, *The Akáthistos Hymn,* for Cappella Romana.


